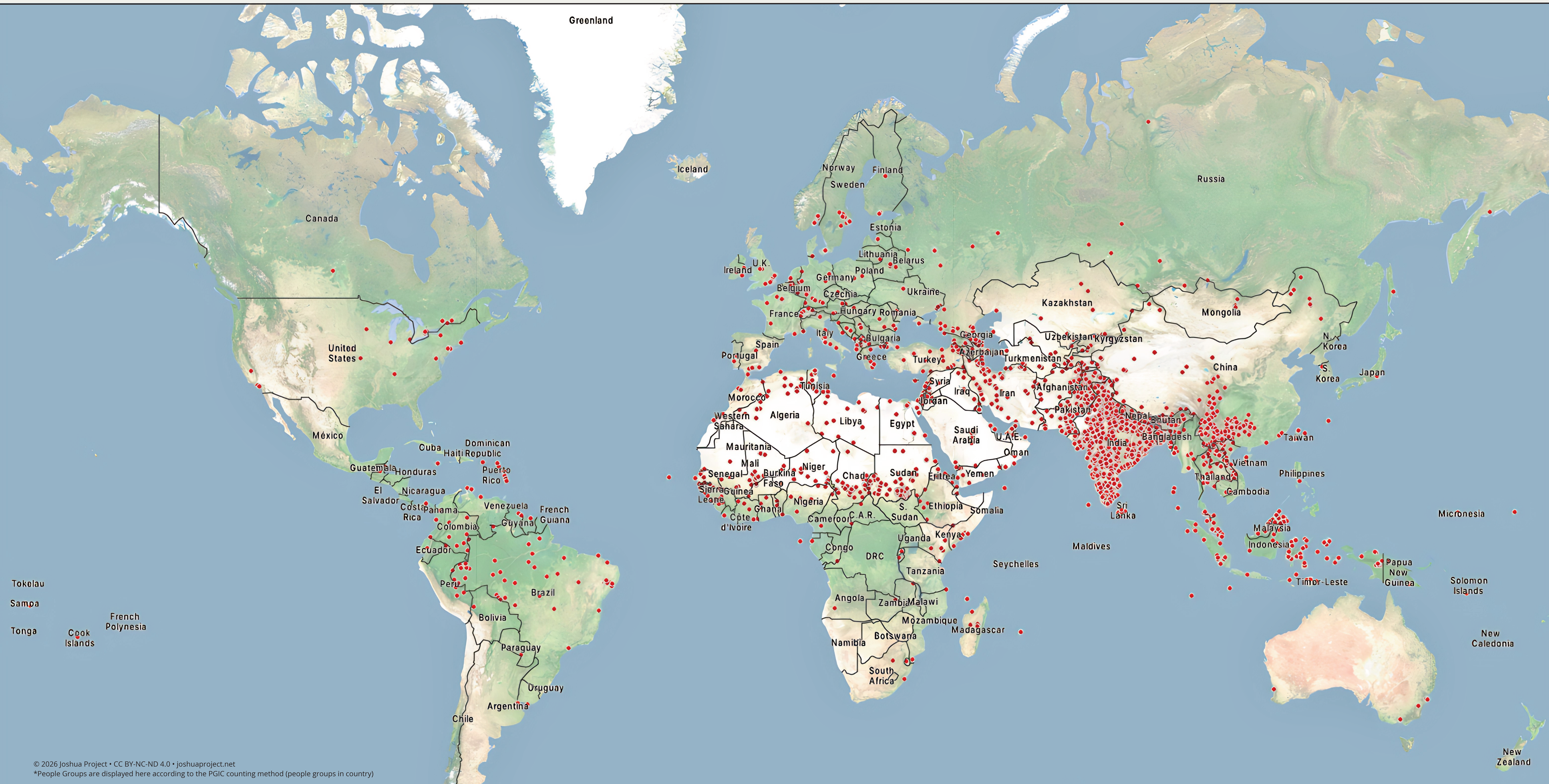


# Frontier People Groups

1a	Unreached (Frontier) <span style="color: red;">★</span> Less than 1 in 1,000 (0.1%) identify as Christians in any way.	Evangelicals <= 0.1% Professing Christians <= 0.1%	24%
1b	Unreached (non-Frontier) <span style="color: red;">■</span> Few evangelicals and little, if any, history of Christianity.	Evangelicals > 0.1% and <= 2% Professing Christians > 0.1% and <= 5%	19%
1	Unreached (All) <span style="color: red;">★ + ■</span>		43%
2	Minimally reached Few evangelicals, but significant number who identify as Christians.	Evangelicals <= 2% Professing Christians > 5% and <= 50%	3%
3	Superficially reached Few evangelicals, but many who identify as Christians. In great need of spiritual renewal and commitment to biblical faith.	Evangelicals <= 2% Professing Christians > 50%	7%
4	Partially reached Evangelicals have a modest to moderate presence.	Evangelicals > 2% and <= 10%	24%
5	Significantly reached Evangelicals have a significant presence.	Evangelicals > 10%	23%
