Position Summary:

Specialists in graphic design, video, writing, social media, and email marketing could strategically contribute to Joshua Project's mission. The role will use specific skills to contribute to Joshua Project's overall communications strategy in playing our role to see God glorified through an abundance of Christ followers within every people group.

<u>Essential Roles and Responsibilities</u> (dependent on skills of applicant and strategic needs of the organization. Could include tasks such as the following):

Graphic Design: Potential activities include social media post design, web design styling, designing printable resources such as booklets and maps, creating infographics, and designing other digital resources using Joshua Project information.

Video: Potential activities include creating videos to be used by the global church in multiple languages highlighting unreached people groups, countries or regions with unreached concentrations, and strategic initiatives like reaching frontier people groups. Could also involve creating how-to videos in navigating the Joshua Project site and using it for mobilization.

Social Media: Manage and build Joshua Project's social media communities and engage with them to share Joshua Project content with others. This role would include seeking to build communities in multiple parts of the world.

Email marketing: Help build and maintain Joshua Project's email marketing audience through our regular email updates as well as automated prayer plans for various countries, regions, and initiatives.

Writing: Participate in writing content for people group profiles, publications, social media, webpages, and other initiatives.

Knowledge, Skills and Abilities:

- Specialized skills to match communications role
