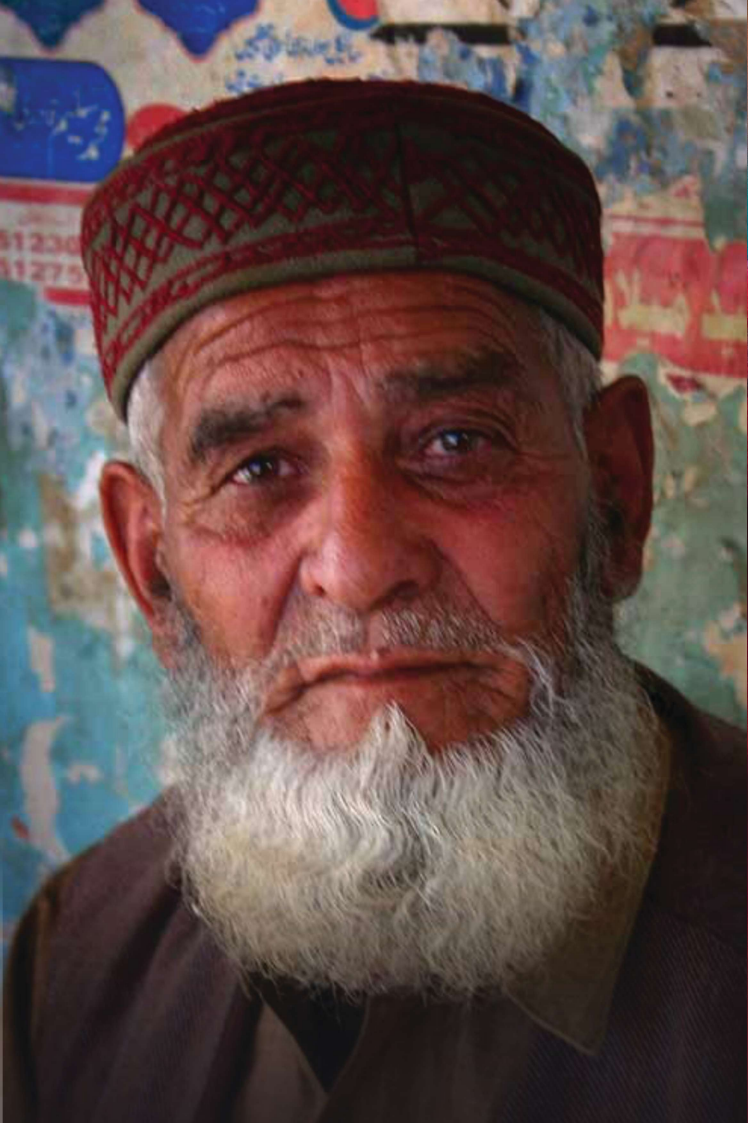

Not Just Geography

Followers of Jesus are commissioned to "go make disciples of all nations" (Matthew 28:19). But "**nations**" in the original Greek means "*ethne*"—ethnic groups. The call isn't just to modern nation-states, but to every distinct people group on earth.

Highlighting the Hidden

Joshua Project identifies the peoples and places with the least access to the gospel. These are the ethnic groups that remain unknown and hidden—communities where followers of Christ are absent. We provide the destination map for the Great Commission, empowering the global Church to prioritize its prayer and mission efforts.

Our Database, Your Vision

We maintain a comprehensive people group database and track what God is doing among these communities. **Our goal:** To assist the global Church in seeing Christ followers within every people group.

Note: An unreached or least-reached people is a group among which there is no indigenous community of believing Christians with adequate numbers and resources to evangelize without outside assistance. All people groups featured have fewer than 2% followers of Jesus.
