



Amarakaire in Peru

The Amarakaire are a highly divided people group. Once consisting on up to 18 antagonistic subgroups, they now are divided into only five. After living isolation, the Amarakaire's population was wiped out by 95% in the 20th century due to sicknesses spread by rubber traders. They live in the southern jungle region of Peru and live a daily subsistence lifestyle based on farming, fishing and hunting.

Ministry Obstacles

The people group has developed a strong dislike of missionary efforts as a whole, which has made efforts at outreach difficult.

Outreach Ideas

Renewed efforts that take away the demonization of following Jesus may be crucial in reaching out to the Amarakaire.
