

Arem in Vietnam



The Arem have their own distinct language, however it is dwindling and today there are only about 20 elderly people who can speak it fluently! It is being replaced by a more general Chut language. According to a Vietnamese government report on the Chut, “Their population numbers are falling alarmingly, and their agriculture is on the point of disappearing.”

Ministry Obstacles

The Arem and the other Chut tribes, have absolutely no awareness of the gospel in either Laos or Vietnam. They remain completely unreached.

Outreach Ideas

To reach the Arem, one will want to reach their elders. This will require translation into the Arem language, so they will not find it threatening.

Pray for the Church

Pray that a church is able to develop among the Arem, being that they currently have no knowledge of Jesus. Pray that this people’s language and culture doesn’t die out, but remains for years to come. Pray for the Lord to guide and protect the Arem people as they face an
