hree principles are said to form basic Bahai doctrine: the unity of God, the unity of religion (that all major religions have the same spiritual source and come from the same God), the unity of humanity (that all humans have been created equal). People are to learn to know and love God through such methods as prayer, reflection, and being of service to humanity. Jesus is but one of many "divine messengers" that have appeared in history. The religion was initially seen as a sect of Islam, with its religious background in Shia Islam. Muslims generally regard followers of Bahai as deserters of Islam, apostates. The Bahai religion arrived in Nepal after World War II.



The Bahai believe that there is only one God. They also believe that all major religions have the same source and same God. They view Jesus as just one of many divine messengers. Such views contradict the Bible.
