

Southern Bai in China



The Bai scarcely qualify as an ethnic minority. Some Bai people deny that they are Han Chinese, and their ethnic label was unknown to them until 1958, according to Operation China. They aren't fully Chinese either. They are known for their use of white marble.

Ministry Obstacles

The Bai are followers of Mahayana Buddhism. Most Bai have yet to receive an intelligible gospel witness in their Minchia language.

Outreach Ideas

The Bai people need the gospel presented in their own language. Christian believers can take them Bible portions. They would especially be interested in hearing of Christ's power over unclean spirits, which torment them regularly.

Prayer Focus

There are few Bai believers. Pray for those believers to build Christian community and to lock arms in unity for the harvesting of the fields. Pray the Bai would see they do not have to live in slavery to spirits if they put their trust in Jesus Christ. Pray for the
