Many consider the Bugis to be the dominant people group in South Sulawesi Island though many have moved elsewhere to seek success and wealth. The Bugis believe that certain days are good days and hold events and activities on the first Wednesday and last Thursday of each month. Conversely, they consider Saturday to be a bad day, with misfortune more likely to happen. The Bugis people are known for their fervent adherence to Sunni Islam though many still follow their traditional system of animist beliefs.
