Though the young people living there often wear Western style clothing, traditional clothing is still common among adults. Children are expected to help with the farming, fishing and caring for the livestock. For recreation, the Comorians enjoy dancing, singing and playing instruments.

Ministry Obstacles

In the past, the Comorians have been very resistant to any religious change. However, more recently they have become more receptive. Any outreach through written materials would be difficult due to the high illiteracy rate.
