

Kabardian in Jordan



Kabardian people hail from Russia's northwestern Caucasus, but some now live in Jordan. They embody remarkable aspects of human beauty and strength. Kabardian youth are trained to serve and defer to elders, and Kabardian national dances reveal this code of honor. The straight backs, regal movements, and modest costuming all display a dignity and pride in their heritage.

Ministry Obstacles

Like all peoples, the Kabardians have darkened hearts. Equal to hospitality as a cultural value is the code of blood revenge. While not always literally practiced, it underscores a generationally ingrained defensiveness and unwillingness to reconcile offenses. Once characterized by folk Islam, Kabardians are now plagued more and more by an encroaching attraction to radicalism among many youths.
