

Hindu Hadi in Bangladesh



The Hadi are Dalits, the lowest status groups in Hindu society. The word Dalit means “broken or scattered.” They are relegated to the lowest most menial jobs, and for the Hadi, that means jobs like collecting trash and sweeping the streets.

Ministry Obstacles

Like other Hindus, the Hadi are fearful of rejecting the traditional religion of their people. To leave Hinduism would be to risk excommunication from their families and losing relationships with loved ones. Those who hear the gospel are reluctant to consider it, despite the freedom from bondage it offers.

Outreach Ideas

Following Christ is a foreign concept to the Hadi. Reaching them will require an insider movement in which Hadi people share the good news with others from their community, testifying to the truth of Christ and demonstrating God’s love.
