

Hani in China



The Hani are a needy and poverty-stricken people. The central government ranked them lowest of China's official minorities in a quality of life index. Traditionally the Hani were one of the most gospel-neglected of China's minorities. The few efforts to evangelize them have been met with resistance.

Ministry Obstacles

There are few resources (Scripture, gospel films, etc.) available to help communicate the good news of Christ to the Hani people.

Outreach Ideas

Christians can minister to the physical and material needs of the Hani, while also recounting stories from Scripture.

Prayer Focus

Pray for the few Hani believers to become effective and fruitful in sowing God's Word among their own families and communities to fuel a movement of God's blessings spreading from household to household. Pray they would be accurately taught the truths of Scripture and would be zealous to grow in the nurture and admonition
