

Lu Mien in China



The Lu Mien form part of the Yao nationality. They farm terraced rice paddies that hang off the sides of steep cliffs. The family unit is very important to the Yao. The Yao religion is a combination of ancestor worship and exorcism of ghosts. They are polytheists, meaning they have many gods.

Ministry Obstacles

They live in gross spiritual darkness and worship a host of gods who can neither hear nor help them. The Yao geography makes access somewhat difficult. More importantly, their worldview is different from the scriptural worldview.

Outreach Ideas

Han Chinese believers can be Christ-bearers to the Lu Mien people. Power encounter should be employed to show Jesus is greater than ghosts and unclean spirits.

Prayer Focus

The Yao are a large people group, and there are some Christian believers among them. Pray for these believers to faithfully fellowship together and come to an accurate understanding of the gospel of
