raditionally, the Katang lived in longhouses, and extended families dwelled under one roof. The Katang people produce textiles and sell them to Western and Asian tourists. They are dispersed over a wide-spread area of southern Laos. In recent decades, many have moved down from the hills onto the plains, where they have lost much of their cultural heritage and are on the way to becoming like the Lao majority.

Obstacles

Most Katang are too bound by fear to consider defying their gods and embracing Jesus Christ. Although most Katang have absolutely no awareness of the gospel or the claims of Jesus Christ, there is one Katang church in Laos, with approximately 100 known believers. They have faced great opposition from local authorities, shamans and community leaders, who believe their presence will bring a curse on the village from the spirits they have worshiped for countless generations.

Outreach Ideas

One way to reach the Katang people is through stories from Scripture.
