

Khampti in India



Do you have a prayer room at your home? Do you pray twice a day? The Buddhist Khampti people of Northeastern India make this their practice. These peace-loving people make offerings of flowers and food. They are settled agriculturists, and use a plough drawn by a single animal, either an oxen or a buffalo. They are also renowned for their craftsmanship. Their Buddhist priests use wood, bone or ivory to carve religious statues.

Ministry Obstacles

The Buddhist Khampti people may not understand their need for forgiveness of sin, and that provision for forgiveness has only been provided through Christ's death. Pray for spiritual understanding.

Outreach Ideas

Pray that Indian believers will become wise in sowing the Word of God among Khampti families, multiplying his blessings to many Khampti households.

Prayer Focus

There are followers of Jesus among the Khampti people, although few in number. Pray they will be quick to
