

Northern Kurd in Canada



The Northern Kurds, live along the northeastern border of Iraq, bordering Iran. Some fled further north to escape the persecution of Saddam Hussein and the devastation of the gulf wars. Kurds began to leave Iraq in the early 1990s and their exit continues today. Canada graciously allows many war refugees to enter their country. The largest number of Kurds live in Ontario. There is a Kurdish Youth Association of Canada in Ottawa.

Ministry Obstacles

There is a short window of opportunity to reach refugees before they get settled and assimilated. That time has passed for almost all Kurds in Canada.

Outreach Ideas

Christian believers can establish a Christ-honoring youth club for Kurdish youths who don't fit into any culture. Christians can help them adjust while helping them to put their identity in Christ.

Prayer Focus

Christian believers need to be grounded in faith in the risen Christ, and disciple others to do the same. Pray that the Kurds in Canada would
