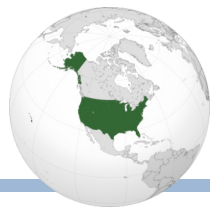


Laven in the United States



The Boloven, or Laven, originate in southwestern Laos. The ancestors of the Boloven were part of the great Khmer Empire that flourished from the ninth century to the thirteenth century. Buddhism in Boloven society serves more as a veneer to traditional ethnic religions involving ancestor worship and animism. The Boloven believe that ancestral spirits remain actively involved in their lives and should be cared for and fed.

Ministry Obstacles

Scripture is not available in the Laven language, and there are no reports of outreach directed toward the Boloven people in the USA.

Outreach Ideas

Who will rise to this opportunity to reach an unreached people group near home? Gospel recordings are available in the Laven language. Perhaps someone in a church near the Boloven people in the United States will offer a recording to someone in this people group.
