Limbu in Bhutan



he origin of Limbu is not certain, but they are clearly of Mongolian descent. Agriculture is their main source of income. Women are very influential within Limbu families, especially if the husbands are in the military and stay away for long periods of time.

Ministry Obstacles

Bhutan is one of the world's least evangelized nations. The Limbu are predominantly Buddhists but participate in many popular Hindu festivals. Their worldview is very different from that of Christ followers.

Outreach Ideas

Limbu people need the hope and joy of knowing their Creator and following the savior who alone can forgive sins and direct their lives.

Prayer Focus

There are no Limbu Christian believers, so pray for Christ's ambassadors from nearby Nepal and India to reach them. Pray for a movement in which the Holy Spirit leads and empowers
