

Yakthumba, Limbu in Nepal



Limbu people compose one of the largest tribal groups in eastern Nepal. The origin of the Limbu is uncertain, but they are clearly of Mongolian descent. Although the abundance of land has made cultivation of new acreage possible, productivity is greatly limited by insufficient technology. Many of the men are in military service and leave their families for long periods. Consequently, women have much responsibility and influence within their families.

Ministry Obstacles

The gospel is very hard to access for these remote people.

Outreach Ideas

Disciples who are knowledgeable in farming and related technology might fill a need in this area to develop relationships and share the gospel. Ministry to women and children may be welcomed in the absence of husbands/fathers. Introduction to Christian fellowship and values may open doors to the good news of eternal life provided by almighty God for Yathumba Limbu in Nepal.
