

Chut in Vietnam



The Chut live on both sides of the Vietnam-Laos border, east of Phuc Trac and southeast of the Arem. Chut women find edible roots, snails, vegetables, and mushrooms on the forest floor. Chut men hunt small game using traps and crossbows with poisoned arrows, and they use dogs to track animals during large-scale hunting expeditions.

Ministry Obstacles

No scripture or Christian resources of any kind are available in the Chut language.

Outreach Ideas

Seek out "bridges of God" and redemptive analogies. The various Chut tribes share a common belief in a Creator God. Workers should be able to use this belief as a springboard into an explanation of what Christians believe to be true about this creator God.
