The Minangkabau people are well known for their tradition of merantau, which is going to distant areas to seek success. Many of them have moved to other islands in Indonesia to accomplish this. In the 1800s, the Dutch took advantage of a conflict between the Minangkabau cultural guardians and Muslim leaders, intervening to gain control of the area. Islam was used as a rallying point in the struggle against the Dutch and resulted in Islam being incorporated into Minangkabau traditions.

Islam is firmly entrenched in the Minangkabau people as part of their identity.

Individuals living outside their original home area are often somewhat open to new perspectives. Perhaps workers can seek these individuals and share the love of Jesus with them.
