In Brazil, Jews form a distinct religious and ethnic minority. Jewish identity is often defined in secular terms, such as language and family traditions, rather than strict religious observances. Childhood plays a crucial role in understanding Jewish identity with storytelling, participation in rituals and festivals and Jewish education being important aspects.
