he main difference between Qizilbash tribes and other Turkic people is that they are Shia Muslims. Therefore, the name Qizilbash is usually applied to them only. Though they are no longer a cohesive group of people, they hold on to their ethnic pride. Those who live in either Turkic countries or Pakistan are a religious minority since their neighbors are Sunni Muslim. Sometimes there is violence against Shia Muslims in Pakistan. In Pakistan, they are often urban professionals: doctors, teachers, engineers and lawyers.



The Qizilbash regard their rulers as divine figures and are considered by orthodox Shias as fanatics. This builds even more of a wall between themselves and the Christ who came to save all nations.
