

Semnani in Iran



A small people group in the rugged areas of northern Iran, the Semnani may have relation to ancient Medes and the Persians of old. As rural herdsmen, their history runs deep in Iran, yet little is known about them. Like many rural Iranians, the Semnani suffer from unsanitary conditions, disease outbreaks, illiteracy, and severely under-developed services.

Ministry Obstacles

The Semnani are virtually all Muslim. Iran remains closed to traditional missionary work. Only sustained intercession can open the hearts of these people to Jesus, the only savior.

Outreach Ideas

The Semnani people need schools, medical clinics, and personnel with eternal hope to staff them. Although Iran remains closed to traditional missionary work, there is a strong and growing church. Semnani people need Iranian believers to take Christ to their communities.

Prayer Focus

Pray for loving Christ followers in Iran to reach the Semnani people, resulting in a movement to Christ. Pray for the Lord to raise up a faith-filled church
