Introduction: Music is important to the She. They sing while working in the fields or while celebrating festivals. When a guest comes to a village, the She request songs. Most She spend their days tending to rice fields on their hilly land, which also yields cotton, tea and grain. The main religious adherence among the She is Daoism, which they mix with ancestor worship. Although there are scattered Christian communities among the Chinese who live near them, the gospel has never taken root among the She.

Ministry Obstacles

The She may have observed the practice of Christianity in neighboring peoples and found it unattractive. Nominal Christianity has that effect.

Outreach Ideas

Perhaps workers will be sent to the She people who can communicate the gospel using oral means since they have a tradition of valuing oral communication.

Prayer Focus

Pray that the few She believers would hunger to share Christ as Lord
