The Baloch are an ancient, seminomadic tribal group that occupy an area of land stretching across Iran, Afghanistan and Pakistan. They first settled there in the fifth century. The Baloch in Iran have been isolated for many years. Balochmayar is the honor code by which the Baloch live. These principles include extending hospitality and mercy, dealing with each other honestly and offering refuge to strangers.

The Baloch may have acquired an incorrect understanding of what Christianity is by observing people who are Christian in name only.

Christian workers need to minister to the physical needs of the Baloch without neglecting their spiritual needs.
