Western Baloch in Turkmenistan



he Baloch people give high status to poets and professional minstrels. Their original homeland reaches from eastern Balochistan to southwestern Punjab, which straddles India and Pakistan. This high, dry region was once a very populated country, watered by many flowing rivers. Today, it is a barren area of rocky mountains and dry river valleys mixed with desert land. It is difficult to make a living in the region, so there is a large Baloch diaspora. Some have migrated to Turkmenistan.

Ministry Obstacles

The Baloch are Sunni Muslims who seldom accept outside ideas. Very little mission work is taking place among the Baloch of Turkmenistan. Illiteracy rates are very high, which makes it difficult to share the written word in their communities.

Outreach Ideas

Literacy teachers for the Baloch could be an important ministry to them. Audio and visual aids could also be helpful.

Prayer Focus

Pray the church would be strengthened and that it would take
