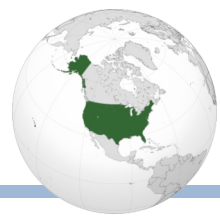


Wolof in the United States



Wolof Senegalese people are hardworking and resourceful. They work as interpreters at Harlem Hospital, and they are shop owners, restaurant and travel agency managers, and vendors on Manhattan streets. They fund one of the largest mosques in West Africa. There are three radio stations among them in the Wolof language.

Ministry Obstacles

Wolof people enjoy unity among themselves by speaking their own language, but they potentially insulate themselves from those who would bring them the gospel.



Outreach Ideas

Wolof dependency on the community of New York might result in openness to the gospel. New York churches might help bring many Wolof people to Jesus Christ by working with missionaries from abroad. Immigrants could be very effective in presenting the gospel message to their families in West Africa.
