

Central Tibetan in Switzerland



Nomadic tribes roamed Tibet as early as the second century BC. Most Tibetans live in Tibet, which is now a province in southwestern China, but a sizable number fled to northern India decades ago. There is a smaller Tibetan diaspora in other countries like Switzerland. The first Tibetans to enter came in the 1960s, and the climate and terrain of Switzerland made a good place for them.

Ministry Obstacles

Tibetan Buddhist religion is the core identity of the people. It was placed over the powerful Tibetan religion of Bon, which is a mixture of magic, divination, demon worship, and shamanism.

Outreach Ideas

Tibetans in Switzerland have an opportunity to break the bondage of the spirit world and embrace Jesus Christ in their European homeland. The complete Bible, audio, and visual resources are available in the Tibetan language.

Prayer Focus

Pray that strong Bible-believing and teaching churches will rise up to reach Tibetan people in Switzerland.
