Eritrean Tigre in Eritrea



The population of Eritrea is equally divided between Christian (Orthodox, Roman Catholic and Lutheran Protestants) and Muslim religions. The largest Muslim group is the Tigre, the only Eritrean or Ethiopian Semitic people which is not Orthodox. They are related to the Christian Tigrinya but are culturally distant from them.

Ministry Obstacles

Cultural barriers are high. These can be overcome, but it usually requires much time.

Outreach Ideas

Tigre believers can become effective and fruitful in sowing God's word among their own families and communities to fuel a movement of God's blessings spreading from household to household.

Prayer Focus

The few Tigre believers live in trying circumstances among their Muslim family and friends. Pray for them. Pray they would keep the unity of the Spirit in the bond of peace. Pray the



Tigre people would have sufficient food in an area that often experiences famine. Pray for rain and improved living conditions.
