The Oromo people were once united in dialect and religion. Today, however, they are divided into subgroups with individual dialects and religious practices. The Wollo Amhara are among the least known of the Oromo peoples in Ethiopia.

Ministry Obstacles

Like many of the Oromo groups, the majority of the Wollo Amhara are Muslim. When confronted with a need or crisis, they also seek help from traditional religion. Very few have chosen to follow Jesus, and it is unacceptable in their community to do so.

Outreach Ideas

There are nearby Christians. These believers are in a good position to share the gospel and make disciples.

Pray for Wollo Amhara Christian believers to be filled with the Holy Spirit and ready to disciple others who want to find their way to true holiness. Pray for the Wollo Amhara to have the opportunity to hear and respond to the good news of Christ.
