



Yakkha in Nepal

The Yakkha are a tribal group of Mongolian descent living in nearly 600 villages throughout the mountains of eastern Nepal. The Yakkha subsist primarily as mountain farmers, but the men do have a tradition of migrating to the cities for work. The economy is weak due to their poor agricultural system. The abundance of available land has made cultivation of new lands possible, but inadequate technology limits the productivity of Yakkha farms.

Ministry Obstacles

The government of Nepal is opposed to any form of proselytizing, but there are even more problems from family members than from the government.
