

Romania Jews In Israel



In April 2019, the Jewish Community of Husi, Romania witnessed a tragic scene. Their cemetery had been broken into by vandals that smashed and toppled 73 gravestones of their families. Sadly, this disturbing action was not a surprise to them. Anti-Semitism was continuing to grow in Romania, and many were afraid to let people know they were Jewish. Romania's Jewish population has plummeted from 800,000 before WWII to a tiny remnant. During WWII, up to 380,000 Jews were killed in Romanian state-held territories, and following the war, thousands of Romanian Jewish families immigrated. The majority of Romanian Jews in Romania are older. Their history has almost been eliminated.

Ministry Obstacles

Their painful past and the increase in anti-Semitic actions at the hands of false Christians have caused many Romanian Jews to be guarded against "Christians."

Outreach Ideas

Christians need to reach out to Romanian Jews in friendship, so they can develop trust. This may open a way to discuss God's Word with them. The internet and radio Bible Broadcasts are excellent tools to reach Romanian Jews.
