

Agri in India



The Agri are a Hindu people native to suburban Mumbai. They also live in Rajasthan, Delhi and Maharashtra. They speak Marathi. Both husband and wife are responsible for household income and management, as there is no dowry. The Agri make a living through business, principally through real estate and fishing.

Ministry Obstacles

The idea that God could have a personal relationship with us is unknown to them; thus, to have personal saving faith in Christ is also unknown. The Agri believe they must work for enlightenment to be free of rebirths. Indeed, the idea of being “born again” is easily misunderstood.

Outreach Ideas

Churches should adopt this people and seek to use electronic media and literature to evangelize the Agri. They should also pray without ceasing for a harvest among these Hindus.

Prayer Focus

Pray that Indian churches would adopt this group. Pray that the Holy Spirit would prepare the Agri to
