Amat people are also known as the Amanats. They are farmers, though some are artists, day laborers or carpenters. They speak Odia, which is the language of Odisha, their home state. Like many Hindu communities, the Amat people place themselves higher in the caste system than others would.

Ministry Obstacles

Like many Hindu groups, the Amats' spiritual lives are crippled by astrology, which they believe determines their destiny. Astrologers help them determine auspicious dates for important events like weddings.
