



Deori in India

The Deori have successfully preserved their tribal identity by avoiding racial mixing and intermarriage. Their region in northeastern India has very little industrial development, so they rely heavily on agriculture for sustenance. Deori extended families live together in one dwelling.

Obstacles

Deori religious practices involve the worship of household deities, elemental gods and the entire pantheon of Hindu gods. It will take major spiritual breakthroughs for them to understand their need to put all their faith in the risen Christ.

Outreach Ideas

Dedicated Christian workers can engage with the Deori and minister to their spiritual needs. Prayer is essential for seeking the liberation of the Deori from worshiping creation instead of the Creator.

Pray for the Lord to call forth missionaries who will lovingly serve among the Deori. Pray for opportunities for the few Deori
