migrant community, the Darjee are sometimes known as Damai. They are nonvegetarian, and rice is their staple cereal. The Darjee women play a significant role in their economy by plucking tea leaves in tea gardens for wages. The traditional occupation of the Darjee is tailoring, and some Darjee are musicians. They regard the Kuldevta as their household deity and also worship Vandevta. The live primarily in the Himalayan countries of Bhutan and Nepal, but some are in India.

Ministry Obstacles

The Darjee have a low literacy rate. This limits the ways to get gospel materials to them.

Outreach Ideas

Workers can take them the gospel, especially in oral form. They might need to hear the gospel several times to embrace it.

Pray for the few followers of Christ among this low caste community, that they will follow Christ with zeal and holiness. Pray they will be rooted and established in love. Pray for the Darjee community to increasingly be
