



Gabri in Iran

The Gabri are a people group who have only been reported in Iran. In the 1800s, almost a million people spoke the Gabri language, but now it is disappearing. Despite conversions to Islam, they have remained faithful to the monotheistic Zoroastrian religion, which dates back to the days of the Persian Empire. Zoroastrianism is one of the oldest remaining religions to date.

Obstacles

Though the Gabri have religious commonalities with Jews and Christians, very few have embraced the Savior. It is difficult for outreach efforts to reach a small group that is quickly disappearing.

Outreach Ideas

Outreach to this people group would have to be very specific and reach their individual needs. This is a group that has suffered much abuse by outsiders, so it will be necessary to first win their trust. Perhaps works of compassion will be effective.

Prayer Focus

Pray that the Gabri would have good health and strength in their
