Jad in India



ndia is known for having millions of Hindus and Muslims. Did you know there are also Buddhists who live in India? The Jad people live in north central India and practice Buddhism. Their type of Buddhism is combined with animism, the belief that spirits inhabit the objects of nature. The traditional occupation of the Jad is taking care of sheep. The small group of Jad people speak at least 12 languages other than their primary language of Khampa. Young Jad people prefer to learn and speak Hindi, Nepali or Eastern Punjabi.

Ministry Obstacles

The gospel seems foreign to people groups like the Jad.

Outreach Ideas

The Bible is currently being translated into Khampa. The God's Story video and audio recordings are currently available in Khampa. Christian believers can distribute these resources in Jad communities.

Prayer Focus

Pray that the few followers of Christ among the Jad would find each other. Pray that the Lord would raise
