Khas in Bhutan



he Khas are mountain dwellers living near or in the Himalayan Mountains. They once formed a powerful kingdom, which extended from Nepal into Tibet. Khas language is claimed to be the forerunner of modern-day Nepali. The Khas live in Bhutan, Nepal, and northeastern India. They are hard workers, who try to make a living by tending crops and livestock in a hard climate.

Ministry Obstacles

The Khas are Hindus, but they blend their religion with Buddhist elements. The gospel is a foreign concept to them.

Outreach Ideas

Though there are no believers among the Khas in Bhutan, the gospel has reached a good number of Khas living in Nepal and India. It will be greatly effective for the people of the same community to take the gospel to their unreached brethren in Bhutan.

Prayer Focus

Pray that the Khas who know Christ will be properly instructed in the truth of the word, will grow in spiritual maturity and in number, and will have a burden to spread the



name of Christ. Pray that the Holy Spirit will fill them with power and enable them to effectively communicate the word. Pray for spiritual hunger among the Khas people in all three countries. Pray for God to raise up full time workers to bring the light of the gospel.
