orku people are low status people who earn very little money. Each week they sell what they can produce through vegetables, the firewood they gather in the forests and other commodities. Those with more power take much of what the Korku earn. They need education, better health care and political empowerment to rise above the cycle of exploitation.

Obstacles

Their primary need is spiritual. They need to be shown the way to the truth of the gospel so their lives can change from the inside out, regardless of their circumstances.

Outreach Ideas

Christ followers with knowledge and experience to help will find many areas of service among needy Korku people.

Prayer Focus

There is no church among the Korku people in Bangladesh. Pray this would change this decade. Pray for the Lord to provide for their physical and spiritual needs as a testimony of his power and love. Pray that Korku
