Mahishya in India



The Mahishya are often landowners, engaged in agriculture. The landless among them earn a living by working as agricultural laborers. Some serve as soldiers, and many pursue white-collar jobs. The Mahishya have a relatively high literacy rate. Generally, both boys and girls study up to the secondary level. They are Hindu, so they depend on Brahmin priests and astrologers as their sacred specialists.

Ministry Obstacles

Spiritual darkness can keep the light of the gospel from having an effect.

Outreach Ideas

Perhaps Christian believers in communities near the Mahishya will be able to help Mahishya Christians become mature in the faith. As they grow in maturity and numbers, they will eventually be capable of reaching the entire community.

Pray that Mahishya believers would learn to walk in the power of God's Spirit and would live lives of obedience with hearts of gratitude
