

Khatri (Muslim) in Pakistan



The Khatri are a trading and business caste. Their name comes from the Sanskrit word “Kshatriya,” which is the second highest of the four castes [groupings] of Hinduism. Many members belong to the middle class and have entered teaching and civil service professions. They are one of the most advanced communities in India. Khatri take their religion seriously. Muslim Khatri celebrate traditional Muslim festivals and fast during Ramadan.

Ministry Obstacles

The Khatri community speaks several languages in Pakistan. Each language subgroup may need its own church planting project.

Outreach Ideas

Pray for gospel radio to be widely available throughout Pakistan in many languages. Pray for funds and for skilled people to create the programming.

None of the Khatri community has reported themselves as Christians to the census, in either Pakistan or India. Pray for many to boldly name
