

Hindu Mochi in Bangladesh



The name Mochi means “cobbler,” a label that describes their place in the caste system as well as the shoe-making occupation this people group holds since most work with leather hides and leather products. In addition to following Hindu traditions, they are divided into clans that involve a complex social ranking system. They can be found in India, Pakistan and Bangladesh.

Ministry Obstacles

Their low literacy rate makes reaching the Mochi a challenging task.

There have been reports of a few Mochi putting their faith in Christ. This small but vital minority could be the key to reaching the rest of this people group.
