



Monpa in India

Monpa means, “blessed by a horse.” Monpa people are known as friendly and hard working. They work in agriculture, trading and breeding of yak and cattle. They grow potatoes in northeastern India.

Obstacles

The Monpa people are Buddhists. The Tawang monastery is the spiritual mainstay of their lives which includes spirit worship and animal sacrifices. This situation leaves no room for a savior who pays for the sins of all mankind.

Outreach Ideas

No written, audio or visual Bible resources are known to exist in the Monpa language. Believers can demonstrate respect for the Monpa language by recording Scripture verses.

Pray for the Church

Pray that Monpa believers would be filled with the power and zeal of the Holy Spirit to take Christ to their community.

Prayer Focus

Pray that Monpa people would see that their old systems of ethics and
