The word pindara is related to alcohol. The Pindara live scattered throughout India and in the easternmost provinces in Pakistan: Sindh and Punjab. They speak Punjabi. They allow for divorce and remarriage. Most of the Pindara own farmland. On the death of the father, sons and daughters both inherit the property, and the oldest son becomes the new family head. The Pindara are Muslims, but they sometimes join Hindus in their festivals.
