Today the Ramgarhia hold the identity as a very well-educated and well-respected people, a significant change from their early low status designation of India. Since the 1700s, Ramgarhia Sikhs have created a new reputation for themselves. Due to the determination of early Ramgarhia influencers, the Indian status system fell in the Sikh community. Known for their craftsmanship skill in carpentry, blacksmithing and masonry the Ramgarhia have contributed much to iconic structures throughout India.

Obstacles

A strong-minded people can resist different worldviews; indeed, the Ramgarhia promote dedication to their traditions and a commitment to Sikh principles. Very few Jesus followers are believed to exist among them.
