



Adi in Bhutan

Bhutan is a landlocked country in South Asia. It is situated in the Eastern Himalayas between China in the north and India in the south. Adi people live mainly in China and India, and only a very small number live in Bhutan. Historically a remote people, the Adi continue to be socially and economically isolated. Even their villages tend to remain separate from one another, governing themselves by individual rules and councils. Wealth is measured in domesticated animals, jewelry and land ownership.

Obstacles

Adi people in Bhutan do not understand that the Lord offers far better guidance than their shamans and religious leaders.

Outreach Ideas

The complete Bible is available in the Adi language, including online, audio and visual resources, as well as the JESUS Film. They lack a personal witness to share the gospel message with them.
