



Bouyei in China

The Bouyei are a Thai-speaking people who have lived in China for about 1,000 years. They have many gods and spirits whom they worship. Both Catholics and Protestants have worked among them. Due to persecution some have moved to Vietnam. Despite having their own language, education today is in Mandarin, the standard language of China. It is unclear if any of the Bible is in their language.

Ministry Obstacles

Only 12 percent have a high school education. Most are resistant to the gospel. They live under a government that despises Christian work.

Outreach Ideas

Storying, radio, television, the JESUS Film may be useful to overcome a lack of education and lack of interest in Christ.
