The Western Ghao-Xong people's high mountain lifestyle shows their longstanding values of perseverance and freedom. Fierce warriors, they fought long for their tribe's independence. They avoided defeat by their inaccessibility and fortitude.

Ministry Obstacles

The Western Ghao-Xong remain resistant to outside ideas due to years of oppression, living in inaccessible mountains and speaking a language not well known by missionaries. They also worship many spirits which separate them from the Lord.

Outreach Ideas

The myth of their venerated ancestors Yayi and Yanu idealizes one's blood sacrifice for the people and the other's leadership of the people into safety. They should be taught that Jesus not only did both, but that he led them into eternal spiritual freedom as well.

Prayer Focus

Pray for the believers to persevere in spiritual battle for the freedom of their unbelieving neighbors from unclean spiritual forces. Pray that the gospel
